

On December 16, 2016, Marquetta James, age 30 of New Haven, was taken into custody at her residence by members of the Woodbridge Police Department's Investigative Services Unit along with New Haven Police. James had an outstanding criminal arrest warrant for a residential burglary which occurred on Pease Road in November 2015. Taken in this residential burglary was a 42" television. Through forensic evidence gathered at the scene, James was linked to the crime and an arrest warrant was issued. James' apprehension on December 16, 2016 came in conjunction with a subsequent residential burglary investigation conducted by Woodbridge Police where a second home in the Pease Road area was burglarized on the night of December 15, 2016. Leads from this second burglary investigation led to James's apprehension. James remains a suspect in the December 15, 2016 burglary, which is still under investigation.

James was charged with 53a-101 Burglary 1st Degree and 53a-125b Larceny 6th Degree. She was unable to post her \$250,000 bond and is currently being held at this Department until December 19, 2016 when she will be arraigned in New Haven Superior Court.
