

**WOODBIDGE CONSERVATION COMMISSION**  
**SPECIAL MEETING MINUTES: 18 March 2021**

**Tree Swallow Nesting Boxes Update**

**High School Turf Field Update**

The Woodbridge Conservation Commission sent a letter to the Woodbridge Board of Selectmen and the Amity Board of Education regarding the turf field at Amity High School. At the time of this meeting, it was unclear as to what the status of the field is. The group discussed a possible campaign to encourage residents in town to obtain baseline well testing through the regional water authority.

**Land Use Designations**

Jason Morrill presented the updated land use designations prepared by WCC member Tim Austin. For the next meeting, the group will practice using the new use designations on the following properties and report back: Fitzgerald Tract, Town Center campus, Darling House and 57 Park Lane before it was purchased.
