Commissioner Paul Harrigan and Joi Prud'homme discussed looking into the many grants available from the State of Connecticut for Pollinator Pathways. They will inquire with the National Resource Conservation Services. (NRCS). They are still researching the types of Grants that can be applied for.

Commissioner Paul Harrigan stated they were still in the early stages on the Tree Preservation Proposal. They have been researching other Towns that do have Ordinances in place.

Work Session was held regarding the 66 properties that should/should not be listed on the Properties Worthy of Acquisition/Preservation List.

The update for 124 Seymour Road is that there will be an auction on July 1, 2023. Trail Master Andy Danzig has been receiving his equipment. No easements were brought up at the Board of Selectman meeting regarding the property at 7 Forest Road.
