

Woodbridge Coronavirus Update, March 16

- Town offices and buildings remain closed to the public but staff continue reporting to work. If you need assistance with anything check the Town website woodbridgect.org or call 203 389 3400 to be transferred to the appropriate department. - Board of Finance Meeting on March 19: Any member of the public who would like to submit public comment to the Board of Finance may do so via email by 4:30 pm on Thursday March 19 to Karen Crosby at kcrosby@woodbridgect.org. Please indicate in the subject line that the email is intended for public comment. Since buildings are closed to the public no public are allowed inside the building.
- Woodbridge Human Services is arranging to deliver groceries from the Town's Emergency Fuel and Food Fund to the homebound elderly. The Town's Social Worker is also checking in with local seniors regarding their needs. If you are worried about your neighbor or another resident please call Human Services at 203-389-3429 to add them to the list. If you would like to help, call to get on the volunteer list. Any qualifying family in need can call to discuss food and other services.
