PRESS RELEASE

Motor Vehicle Accident - Firearm Possession – Arrest Made

On Wednesday, November 10, 2021, at approximately 7:30 p.m., members of the Woodbridge Police Department responded to a report of a motor vehicle accident at the intersection of Amity Road (Rte. 63) and Seymour Road (Rte. 67). Upon arrival and speaking with the operator, Officers observed what they believed to be a firearm concealed in the operator's hooded sweatshirt pocket. Upon attempting to secure the firearm the operator struggled with Officers and attempted to flee on foot. After a short foot chase, the operator later identified as Jordan Driffin, age 19, of Waterbury, CT, was taken into custody and the firearm was secured. Inspection of the firearm revealed it was a loaded 9mm semi-automatic handgun, with a high-capacity magazine and an obliterated serial number. Driffin's vehicle was found to contain marijuana packaged for sale and other drug paraphernalia.

Driffin was charged with the following:

Criminal Possession of a Firearm
Illegal Weapon in a Motor Vehicle
Illegal Alteration of a Firearm's Identification
Illegal Possession of a High-Capacity Magazine
Interfering with an Officer
Possession of Marijuana with Intent to Sell

Driffin was unable to post his \$100,000 bond and was held at Woodbridge Police Headquarters until November 12, 2021 when he was transported to New Haven Superior Court and presented for arraignment.
