

DOG LICENSE APPLICATION

TOWN OF WOODBRIDGE

Connecticut State Statutes require that all dogs six months and older be licensed in the town in which they live. In order to obtain a license, you must have a current rabies vaccination for your dog.

Dog Licenses can be obtained in person at Town Hall or by application through the mail, both using this form. (New for 2025 – RENEWALS ONLY, with current rabies vaccination date, may be requested online.) If your dog's rabies vaccination has expired, a current rabies vaccination certificate must be included with your application. Once your information and payment have been processed, a dog tag and printed license will be issued. Your dog should wear the tag at all times.

The licensing period is from July 1st through June 30th. Licenses must be renewed each year during the month of June or a monthly penalty of \$1.00 will apply. Renewal reminders are mailed in late May to currently-licensed dog owners.
